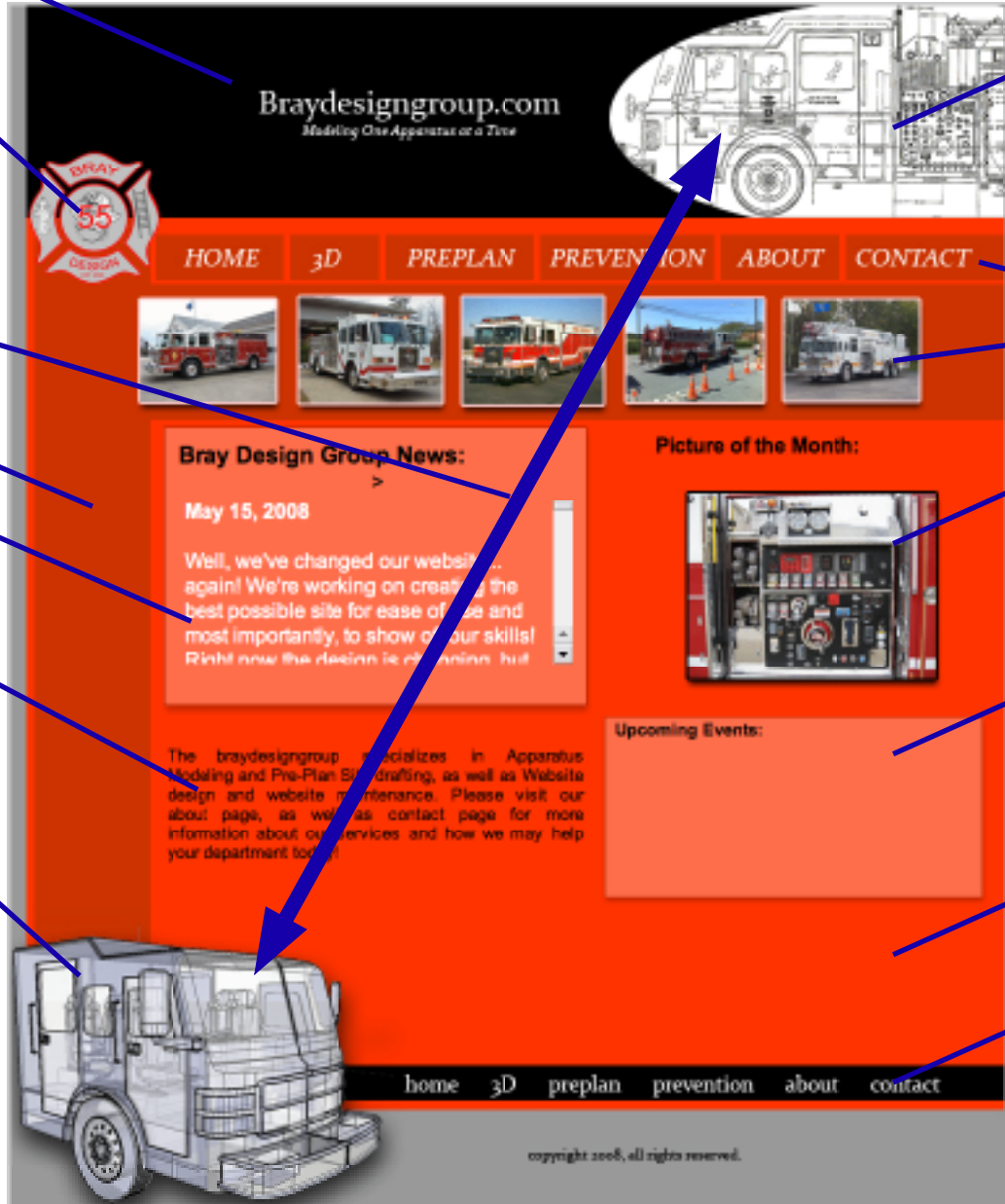
This Logo is part of the USA Fire Engine tradition but I feel it is lost in this location. Maybe just hold on to the 'idea' of the logo and have it combined with the Site Name / Slogan!

Link the 2D Drawing with the 3D Model Using a Red Band

Consider using White Text on Black for the window

Black text on red is difficult to read. Consider plain White on Black or Black on White. Actually I would go for a tri colour scheme, Red, Black and White.

The transparent 3D model is a good idea but drop the profiles and get rid of the 'join'



I can see what you are trying to achieve here, the 2D drawing to a 3D model at bottom! BUT they are not linked visually! You might consider using that Fire Engine Red band (on left) as the visual link? BTW I think this would be MORE than enough RED on the page.

These are a little flat, maybe try relief effect buttons

The pictures are fine as they show what you are all about. Just maybe loose the white frame and let them 'float' with a soft shadow?

Line up the 'Picture of the Month' with the actual picture and again float it with a soft shadow and drop the black frame / line.

If you need to have this info space be sure to fill it with data

TRY a white or GRAY background
