


PROBLEM:

"Drag and Drop" not working in Windows 8 [or Win7].

SOLUTION:

- Open CMD (Command Prompt) as administrator.

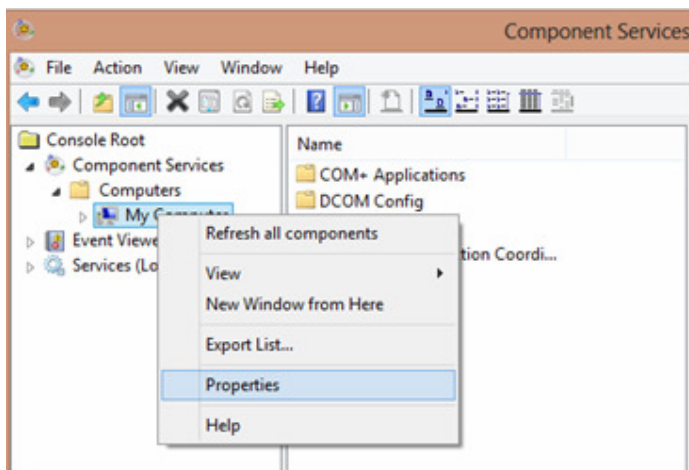
In the command prompt, type `dcomcnfg`



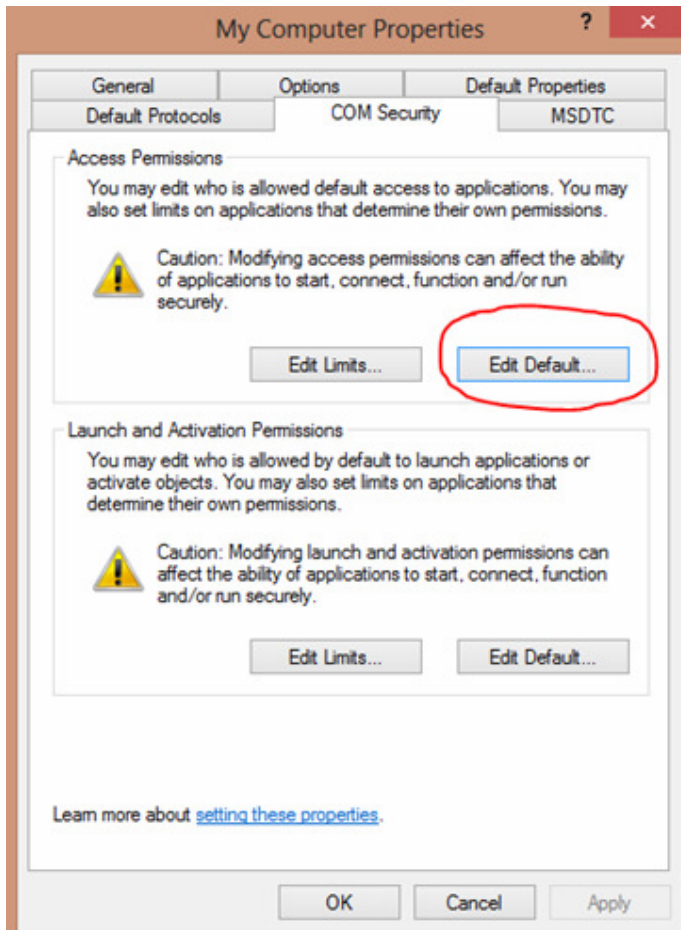

- Expand **Console Root** -> **Component Services** -> **Computers** -> **My Computer**.

Right-click **My Computer** and select **Properties**

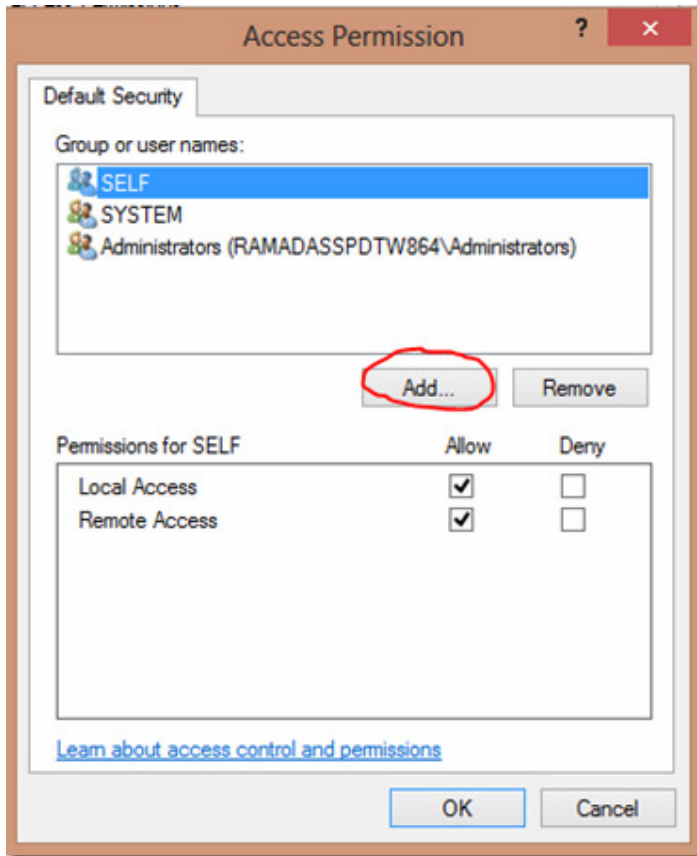


- Traverse to **COM Security** tab and click **Edit Default** under **Access Permission** container

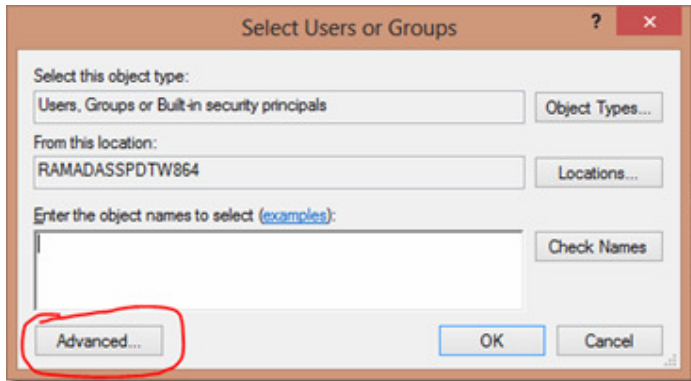


- Both **System** and **Interactive** groups should be listed with 'Allow Access'.

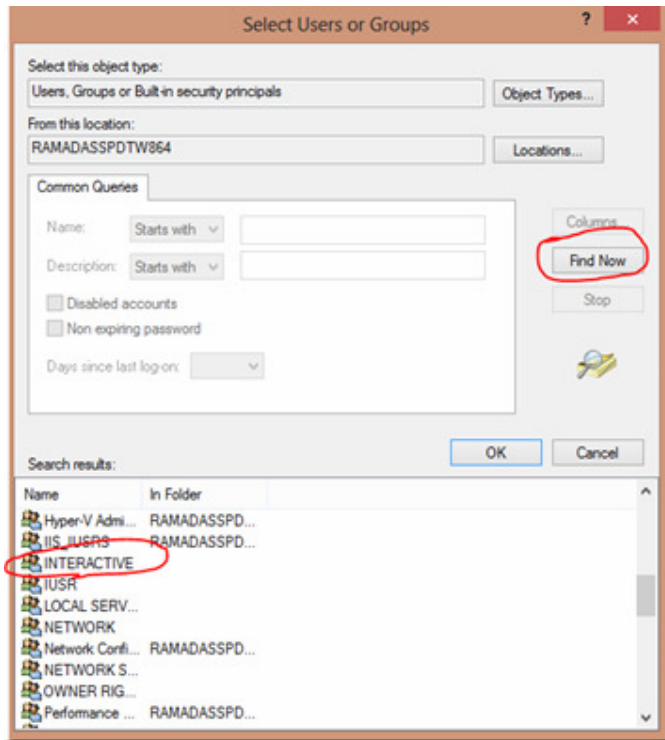
If either of these are missing, then first add them by clicking **Add**



- Select *Local computer name* in the Location and click **Advanced** button



- Click **Find Now** Button and select **INTERACTIVE** group from the list and click **OK**



- Click **OK**
