

Toolbars Sets for SketchUp 2015 and higher (Free and Pro)

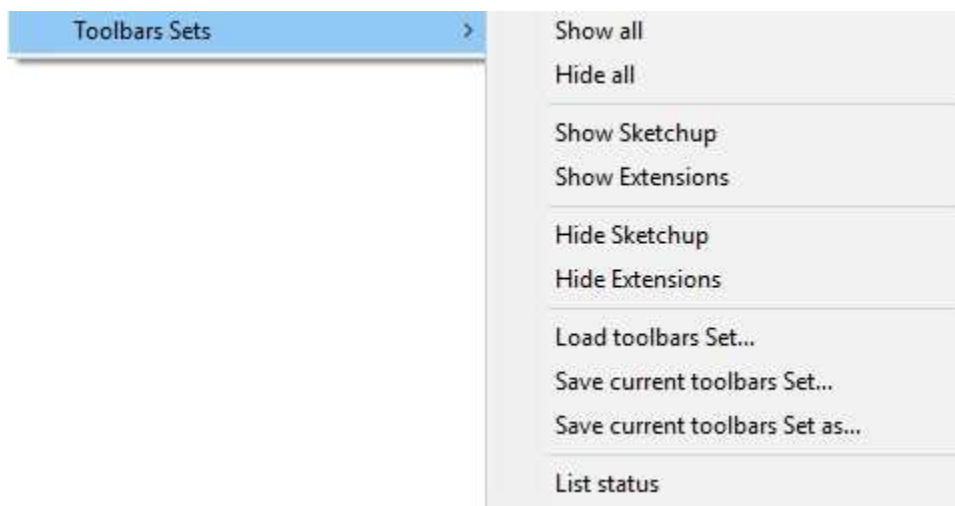
This plugin adds several menu commands to hide, show, save; restore, list, the 2 categories of toolbars of the SketchUp interface: SketchUp toolbars and Plugins (aka Extensions) toolbars.

It can also save and load toolbars "sets".

Important: since the locations of the toolbars on the screen are not exposed in the Ruby API ☹ (but stored in the registry), the plugin can NOT restore these locations, only set their visibility.

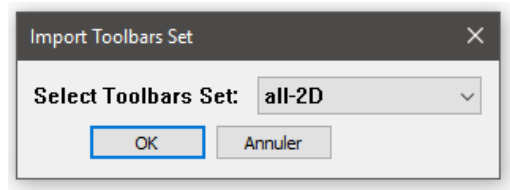
Menu items:

Select the **Toolbars** item of the **View** menu:



- **Show all:** will display all the toolbars that you set in the View > Toolbars menu of SU
- **Hide all:** will hide all the toolbars that you set in the View > Toolbars menu of SU
- **Show SketchUp:** will display all the Sketchup's toolbars that you set in the View > Toolbars menu of SU
- **Show Extensions:** will display all the plugins toolbars that you set in the View > Toolbars menu of SU
- **Hide SketchUp:** will hide all the Sketchup's toolbars that you set in the View > Toolbars menu of SU

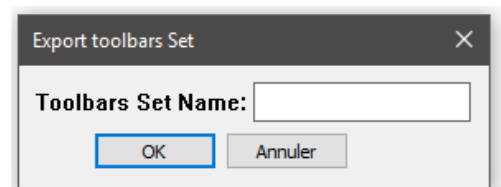
- **Hide Extensions:** will hide all the plugins toolbars that you set in the View > Toolbars menu of SU
- **Load toolbars set...:**



select a set in the dropdown list, this will import a previously saved set of toolbars and restore all the toolbars status. If you installed or uninstalled an extension after the set have been saved, the toolbar(s) of this extension will be ignored. If no sets are found, you'll get this message:



- **Save current toolbars set:** will export all the toolbars status in an external file named "current.tbv" in the Toolbars Sets sub-folder of the Plugins folder.
- **Save current toolbars set as...:**



enter a name for your set and click OK, this will export all the toolbars status in an external file that you can load later.

- **List status:** will display a dialog with all the toolbars by category and their status (visible or invisible)
